OUR PROMISE TO YOU: At Rei Judo Academy we promise to provide Judo classes in a safe and fun environment. All Judo instructors are fully qualified, DBS checked, first aid trained and have an up to date safeguarding qualification.

WHY ARE WE UNIQUE: Our focus and goals are to teach and improve confidence, focus and problem solving skills through the martial art of Judo for all members, also being able to use these skills not just for Judo but for everyday life and challenges our members might face.

PARTICIPATION RULES: All Academy members are expected to follow the **Judo Moral Code** while participating during the Judo class. All members are expected to listen and follow the coach's instructions. All members are expected to be kind and considerate to others on and off the Judo mat.

Judo Moral Code

- ✓ Courtesy To be polite to others
- ✓ Courage To face difficulties with bravery
- ✓ Honesty To be sincere with your thoughts and actions
- ✓ Honour To do what is right and stand by your principles

WHAT TO WEAR: During the class Academy members must wear the full Judogi (Judo Kit) from Rei Judo Academy, Jacket, trousers and belt. Girls must wear a t-shirt underneath the Judo jacket, for boys a t-shirt is optional. All piercings must be taken out or covered up with finger tape or plasters during the class.

BEHAVIOURAL RULES: At Rei Judo Academy, we strongly encourage a fun safe, working environment for all. We, therefore, ask for your support in helping your child to understand the following behavioural rules:

- No swearing
- No malicious behaviour
- No bullying
- No punching, kicking, biting and scratching
- Asking permission when leaving the mat

CLASS FEES: Is a monthly charge to participate on the Judo class. Monthly fees are taken out on the 1st or the 15th of the month through direct debit. Memberships are put into 2 categories:

- Academy Member Judo once a week (£39.99 a month)
- Academy Eagar Member Judo twice a week (£54.99 a month)

JOINING FEE: (£50.00) All new membership direct debit agreements require a joining fee. This joining fee does include one of our beginners packages.

BEGINNERS PACKAGE (Kids): This includes Judo kit, club badge, RJA club t-shirt and grading book.

BEGINNERS PACKAGE (Adults): This package includes Judo jacket, Judo trousers, white belt and club badge.

CANCELLING YOUR MEMBERSHIP: You must give 15 days' notice before cancelling your membership.

REJOINING AFTER CANCELLATION: Re-joining members must repay the re-joining fee (£25.00).

GRADING FEE: (£12.99) There will be an extra charge for gradings. (mon and kyu gradings require a BJA licence)

CHANGING YOUR MEMBERSHIP: Members can upgrade their membership with no extra cost. Down grading membership will come with a £5 charge.

ANNUAL PRICE REVIEW: Once a year there will be an annual price review, membership fees may change each year.

ACADEMY TIMETABLE: Academy classes will run 48weeks of the year, the Academy closes for the last 2weeks in August and the last 2weeks in December. Membership fees will remain the same price when the club is closed.

HOLIDAY POLICY: We will not pause direct debits for members going on holiday.

INJURY POLICY: If a member has a server injury outside of the class and cannot take part in Judo, we will pause direct debits for up to 3 months. There must be a doctor's letter provided.
